THE CITY HEIGHTS COMMUNITY

The Cura Smiles Dental Clinic is located in the vibrant community of City Heights, San Diego, CA.

Known for its ethnic diversity, City Heights is home to 65,000 residents many of whom are immigrants and refugees from Vietnam, Somalia, Cambodia, Laos and Latin America. City Heights is predominantly low-income with a median household income of \$29,000 and experiences high rates of poverty, unemployment, child obesity, and asthma. Many families and individuals in this community lack access to essential medical and dental services.

Through the support of generous donors, Cura Smiles is able to provide dental care free of charge which in many cases is life changing for the individuals.

2021 PATIENT STATISTICS

109

One hundred and nine patients were treated at the Cura Smiles Clinic. The average age of the patients is 44. The average income reported by the employed patients is \$16,200 with 23% being unemployed.



A total of three hundred and fifty seven procedures were performed for the patient population. The procedures include dental exams, x-rays, cleanings, fluoride treatments, sealants, fillings, dentures, extractions and denture relines.

\$84K

The Cura Smiles dental professionals performed over \$84,200 in procedures free of charge. Fillings, extractions and dentures represented 75% of the total value of procedures performed for the patient population.

PATIENT STORY

Meet Selene. Selene is from Mexico. She grew up in a family that only drank Coca Cola. When they ate together, there was no water, no milk, only coke. Until recently, she was drinking 7 bottles a day. Currently she has reduced that to only 3 bottles a day. As you might expect, her teeth and gums were in very poor condition. She suffered from multiple periodontal abscesses. She was embarrassed and afraid to talk or smile because her gums would bleed. She would wake up in the morning and her pillow would be covered in blood from the periodontal disease. When she finally came to Cura Smiles, she was overwhelmed that we wanted to help her. Tears rolled down her cheeks in gratitude. Every provider that has helped her, loves her and wants the opportunity to continue to treat her. Since coming to Cura Smiles, Selene has received 5 fillings, 4 quadrants of scaling and root planing therapy. She's forever grateful.
